It is our sincere and solemn wish to discuss grievances, issues, problems and solutions in a calm, respectful and meaningful way.
 - Hong Kong has always been a resilient, resourceful and reasonable society. Our people are our greatest strength and possess the wisdom and
- wherewithal to handle anything that comes our way. And we will.
- Despite recent disruptions, the fundamentals and institutional underpinning of our economy and society are strong. We remain a safe, open, welcoming and cosmopolitan society and an internationally connected, vibrant and dynamic economy.
- We will no doubt bounce back. We always do.**
