Michael Smith's story "HK delays visa approval for Aussie diplomat" (April 2, print and online) contains two factual errors.

First, Hong Kong is not "independent" from China as stated – Hong Kong is an inalienable part of China. Under "One Country, Two Systems" Hong Kong enjoys a high degree of autonomy except in defence and foreign affairs, which are the responsibilities of our sovereign.

Second, no journalists were expelled from Hong Kong as a result of a decision by the Central People's Government relating to certain journalists working for US media organisations in the Mainland of China.
