The West Kowloon Cultural District (WKCD), spanning 40 hectares, is one of the largest cultural projects in the world. With a variety of performance venues and museums, the WKCD hosts world-class exhibitions, performances, and arts and cultural events, helping strengthen Hong Kong's positioning as an East-meets-West centre for international cultural exchange.

- The Hong Kong Palace Museum displays priceless artefacts of Chinese art and culture from the collections of the Palace Museum, Beijing
- The Xiqu Centre is dedicated to preserving and promoting the art of Chinese traditional theatre
