New landmark in Hong Kong – Kai Tak Sports Park

Kai Tak Sports Park, the future home venue for Hong Kong, is gearing up to become Hong Kong's largest and most comprehensive sports and leisure complex, slated to open in the first quarter of 2025. The 28-hectare Sports Park is part of the redevelopment plan for the former Hong Kong International Airport in Kai Tak.

The Sports Park features a 50,000-seat Kai Tak Stadium with a retractable roof, the Kai Tak Arena with the flexibility to host community sports and events of up to 10,000 seats, and the Kai Tak Youth Sports Ground with a capacity of 5,000 seats.

These venues will be complemented with extensive open spaces for various sports events and entertainment activities together with food and beverages, retail and harbourfront dining spaces.
