Your online video and article *CARTED OFF: Fears China is shipping Hong Kong protesters en masse to secret detention centres as number of uni students 'go missing' (26 Nov)* alleged that the Hong Kong Police have conveyed arrested student protesters to the Mainland by train, with images of protesters being put onto a train in Hong Kong. This is completely untrue. The fact is that on 18 November 2019 the ten or so protesters as shown in the video were arrested as they trespassed on the rail areas of Hung Hom MTR Station. They were taken by train to Mong Kok East Station and were then escorted to a police station for investigation. The Police have affirmed that the arrestees were never conveyed to the Mainland.
